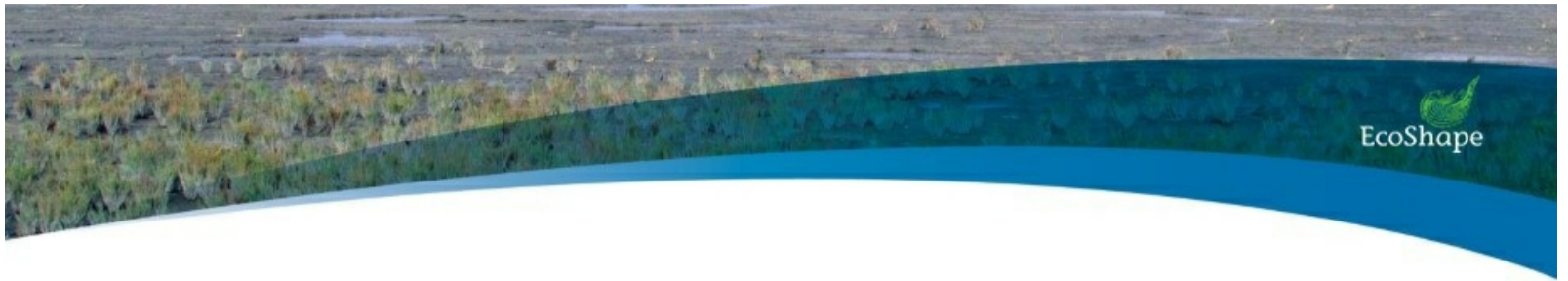


Only 3 weeks to go – join us in Scaling up Building with Nature!
